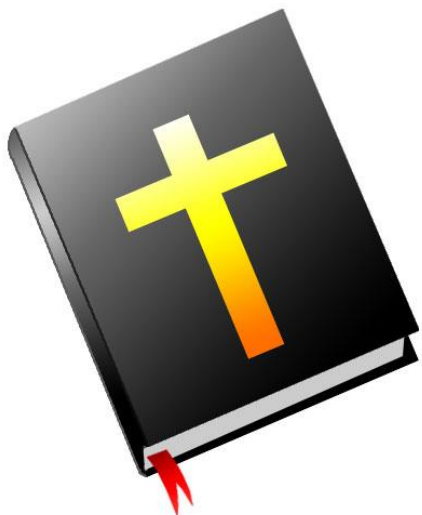

Sunday School

Sunday School (preschool to 6th grade)

Sunday School meets every Sunday from mid-September through late May. Our classes are PreK-Kindergarten, 1st-2nd-3rd and 4th-5th-6th.

All classes meet every Sunday during the Sunday School Session at 9:00 a.m. in the United Methodist Chapel. We do a 5-10 minute opening then the children go with their class and their Shepherd for a lesson.

Our curriculum varies every year. We teach the children Bible Stories, the Ten Commandments, The Lord's Prayer, Books of the Bible, Jesus' life and teachings and how to live a Christian life.

We run the Sunday School Program on a 4-week rotating schedule. During the 4 weeks we teach each class the same lesson but through different workshops, which include:

- Music
- Story telling
- Games
- Memory work
- Foods
- Crafts/Art
- Science

We set aside a few Sundays for Shepherd's Sunday. This time is spent with the Shepherds working on the lesson, learning about the Bible or working on a special project with their class.

Other Activities

Throughout the year the Sunday School children participate in many activities that help the children grow in their Christian faith. Activities include:

- Skits based on the lessons
- Nursing home visits
- Baking cookies
- Movies
- Crafts
- Advent crafts
- Seder Meal
- Christmas Program
- Donating to the local food pantry
- Rally Day
- End of the year party
- Halloween party
- Singing at church services
- Bible verse memorization

Children are encouraged to bring an offering each Sunday. The money is collected and used toward special projects such as:

- Victory Center in Clinton, Iowa
- Food pantry for birthday kits
- Feeding the Children
- April House
- Sheriff's Department
- Helping Hands

Volunteers

Sunday School workshops are led by volunteers with the help of the Shepherds. This is a great experience for the volunteers to meet the youth of your church and for the youth to meet the members of their church.

The curriculums are easy to follow and all materials are given to the volunteers prior to the workshop. **NO EXPERIENCE** is needed to help with workshops. They usually last about 40-45 minutes. There is a 30-minute training required before you can volunteer with the children.
